Environmental Policy

In the course of any IPSC(SA) sanctioned event, the Executive of IPSC(SA), in consultation with the Match Officials, reserves the right to postpone or cancel any or all Stage(s) of the Match should it consider that the environmental conditions (most notably weather and range conditions) for the Competitors exceed those acceptable to Competitor's health and safety.

With specific regards to temperature on the Range:

- When the temperature reaches 36°C, Range Officers shall stop every hour for at least 10 minutes and be supplied with a cool drink in a shaded place;
- When the temperature reaches 38°C, Range Officers shall stop every hour for at least 20 minutes and be supplied with a cool drink in a cool place; and
- When the temperature reaches 40°C, the Executive shall decide whether to postpone (normally until the temperature falls below 40°C) or cancel any or all of the competitive elements of the match or take whatever other action it deems necessary.

Note: Temperature readings are to be taken on the Range in a shady area with a suitable gauge. Area and gauge are to be selected by the Executive.

At all times the Executive shall take whatever action it deems necessary taking into account the prevailing and predicted environmental conditions and Officials and Competitors safety.
